# CLERK'S NOTES

- Please keep the pit lane clear for teams who wish to use it. Spectators must only stand in the areas marked on the day.
- Although you can have as many drivers / pit crew in the pit lane as you wish whilst completing driver changes, please allow plenty of space for other teams as well as keeping the recovery lanes clear. During the F24 race, no adults are to enter the pit area without permission from Greenpower staff.
- Please only use as much paddock space as you need and allow room for other teams to set up their paddocks.
- This is a busy event. Please ensure that you are ready for gridding at the allocated times.
- This season we have noticed a rise in drivers removing their hands from the wheel to wave at or acknowledge their teams. Do not do this under any circumstance as you risk being penalised.
- Make sure that your harnesses are done up tight and secure BEFORE being checked at pit exit or on the grid. We will ask you to return to the back of the queue if these are not done correctly.



# GENERAL INFORMATION

- Catering will be available on the day in the on site café. Although, we do advise you bring your own supply of water and snacks.
- You are responsible for your own waste. Please use on site bins or your own bins and leave nothing behind.
- Greenpower provide on-site medical staff who will be able to assist you with any first aid needs. Please do not hesitate to speak to them if you feel unwell or injured.
- You must respect our code of conduct and respect those around you. Greenpower has a zero tolerance policy towards any behaviour we deem inappropriate.
- Greenpower staff (wearing green high vis) and volunteers (wearing orange high vis) are there to help you compete in a fun and safe manner. Please listen to and follow any instructions given to you and your team.
- Race admin will be able to answer any queries on the day to their best of their knowledge. However, technical queries relating to regulations and design must be directed to our technical team outside of the event.
- To submit a race appeal or race complaint, your team leader must report this to race admin during the race. We will not accept any other form of appeal.
