# CLERK'S NOTES

- All spectators must stand in the designated spectator area.
- Only team members and one team leader will be allowed within the pitlane. All other teachers/staff/parents etc. must stand in the spectator area or stay within the paddocks.
- This is a NEW track layout for Croft and will be significantly longer as well as the inclusion of a hairpin turn. We ask that all teams are confident that they will be able to make this turn safely and to use practice to learn this new track layout. The dimensions of this corner are available upon request.
- This event is a gathering meaning we will also be running Formula Goblins on the day. Both events will be clearly signposted and we ask everyone to stay within their respective boundaries.
- Upon entry please follow signposts and listen to the instructions given by marshals.



# GENERAL INFORMATION

- Catering will be available on the day. Although, we do advise you bring your own supply of water and snacks.
- You are responsible for your own waste. Please use on-site bins or your own bins and leave nothing behind.
