

Dudgeon Grant Application Form

Greenpower Education Trust has been awarded funding from Dudgeon Community Foundation to support schools to participate in the Greenpower project. If successful in your application, you will be granted 50% of the purchase price of a F24 Greenpower kit car, in accordance with the funding rules below.

Funding rules

1. This fund is open to state funded secondary schools to purchase kit cars only.
2. Students taking part in the project should be between the ages 11-16 year olds.
3. Open to schools in Norfolk across the following 3 regions: North Norfolk, Great Yarmouth and Breckland geographical areas.
4. Schools may only apply for one kit car.
5. Where possible, i.e. for mixed gender schools, the Greenpower project should be open to and involve both genders, with an equal as possible ratio of male to female team members.
6. Teams should consist of a minimum of 15 team members but can be larger.
7. Schools must commit to taking part in at least one Greenpower Education Trust event annually.
8. Schools will be required to submit some basic data to Greenpower about your school team. Eg number of team members, number of males/females, amount of contact with any employer partners.
9. Priority will be given to those schools with above average number of pupils claiming Free School Meals (FSM):
 - a. Decisions will be made weekly for schools with above average %FSM
 - b. Decisions will be made monthly for schools with below average %FSM
10. Grant offers are valid for one month only. If a car isn't ordered within one month, the grant becomes void and returns to the grant fund.
11. No cash funding is sent to schools, grant awards will be applied by Greenpower before invoicing for the purchase of the kit car.
12. The grant fund will be finite. There will be times when the grant fund will have to close until new funding from charitable sources is secured. Schools will be informed as soon as possible.
13. Decisions of the Greenpower Grant Committee are final.

Each school must agree to all of these rules and regulations to be eligible for the grant, if you agree please sign below to accept all of the above on behalf of your school.
