# **BEST PRESENTED TEAM:**

# **PORTFOLIO AWARD:**


The Portfolio is the idea platform to show us the design and build process of a new car. In later years, it can be used to show us how much development work the team have carried out, or if you are racing an older car while a new one is being built show us how the new build is progressing. Don't forget, we want to see the teamwork, the entrepreneurship, artwork, leadership and ANY other aspect of the way your team runs.

Use photographs, copies of letters to sponsors (even if they are not successful), lesson plans, team data, achievements and targets.

Then make sure you produce the portfolio in a way that will be easy to judge. If there is video content keep it brief, if it is on tablet make sure your tablet is charged and available for our judges. If it is on CD, DVD or memory stick, make sure it is in a Microsoft Office package that we can access on the day. We are also happy to see the portfolio in analogue forms – books, folders, noticeboard style presentation. Basically, as long as we can view it at the event, we will welcome it! Judging for this award will based on the guidelines. (See separate sheet.)
