

Green Port Grant Application Form

Greenpower Education Trust has been awarded funding from Green Port to support Young people to participate in the Greenpower project. If successful in your application, you will be a maximum of £2,000 to assist the purchase of F24+ kit cars, and running/attendance costs at Greenpower Education Trust race event.

Funding rules

1. This fund is open to support groups/organisations (eg. NEET) based in the Hull and East Riding Council areas only.
2. The young people taking part in the project should be between the ages of 16-24 years old.
3. Teams may only apply for one kit car.
4. Where possible, i.e. for mixed gender teams, the Greenpower project should be open to and involve both genders, with an equal as possible ratio of male to female team members.
5. Teams should consist of a minimum of 15 team members but can be larger.
6. Support groups/organisations must commit to taking part in at least one Greenpower Education Trust event annually.
7. Support groups/organisations will be required to submit some basic data to Greenpower about your team. E.g. Number of team members, number of males/females, amount of contact with any employer partners.
8. Each team will engage with a local business for support and ask the local business to act as a mentor/ambassador. To support their application for the Green Port grant, it is advised that each team will submit a 'plan of action' describing how they will engage with local businesses.
9. Grant offers are valid for one month only. If a car isn't ordered within one month, the grant becomes void and returns to the grant fund.
10. No cash funding is sent to groups/organisations. Grant awards will be applied by Greenpower before invoicing for the purchase of the kit car.
11. The grant fund will be finite. There will be times when the grant fund will have to close until new funding from charitable sources is secured. Groups/organisations will be informed as soon as possible.
12. Decisions of the Greenpower Grant Committee are final.
