

Manly Trust Grant Scheme

Greenpower Education Trust, School Grant Application Form

Please fill in the form below to apply for a grant, thanks to the Manly Trust Fund, to support costs of purchase of a F24 car kit from the Greenpower. If successful in your application you will be granted up to 50% funding for an IET Formula 24 kit car and 50% funding for the carriage fee.

Funding rules

1. This fund is open to only state funded schools or not-for-profit youth organisations in Surrey and Sussex.
2. Where possible, i.e. for mixed gender schools, the Greenpower project should be open to and involve both genders, with an equal as possible ratio of male to female team members.
3. Schools may only apply for one kit car.
4. Schools **must** commit to taking part in their local regional heat at the fee in the next academic year and take part in post-event evaluation.
5. Grant offers are valid for one month only. If a car isn't ordered within one month, the grant becomes void and returns to the grant fund.
6. No cash funding is sent to schools, grant awards will be applied by Greenpower before invoicing for the purchase of the kit car.
7. Priority will be given to schools with a larger than average % of free school meals
8. School/youth organisation must demonstrate that they have raised 50% of the cost already
9. The grant fund will be finite. There will be times when the grant fund will have to close until new funding from charitable sources is secured. Schools will be informed as soon as possible.
10. Decisions of the Greenpower Grant Committee are final.

Each school must agree to all of these funding rules to be eligible for consideration by the Greenpower Grant Committee.
